IV. Report from Show Chair, Angela Edwards

Fall musical, Little Mermaid Jr. Currently we've sold 75 tickets for opening night, 50 for Sat night, 100 for Sunday. We need to encourage people to buy tickets. She ordered novelties from Oriental Trading similar to last year. We made enough money last year to pay for food at the cast party at the end of the show. We have approval to sell concessions from Principal Foster. People are volunteering to man the shows. We need people to throw the cast party. Do we want to do the pizza in the cafeteria or do we want to grill out or something else? Maybe ask parents to donate baked items. Send out a request for assistance from Maestros and Dynamos. Grill outside was a spring event. Vote to do cake and punch in the cafeteria. Will add the Dynamos list to the Maestros volunteer list. T-shirt ETA should be in middle of next week. Will sell those to the kids for \$15. Expand VIP table to Thursday and Friday.

Dynamos turn out seems to be good. Saturday had 11 students for production team, Charles Nasby from UofL, Carl Anderson from Actor's Theater, Allison Anderson is designing Ursula costume. Showcase of Schools this Saturday. Plan to work on production for 5 hours on Sunday afternoon. Also plan to serve pizza after strike on Monday. V. Treasurer's Report by Geoff Glaab

Geoff Glaab presented the October Treasurer's Report in an email prior to the meeting which included bank statements and accounting from September.

Overall, we raised a little over \$7,000 from mum sales. Sales were up from last year and I think our system for distributing them went really well. Ellie making phone calls and sending texts was really beneficial for us.

Our new floor and art panels are on their way, so we'll have some tangible evidence that we're moving in the right direction."

Poinsettia sale isn't worth it because we only made \$100 last year. Deadline is Oct 31st for Fund for the Arts grant. Art Impact matching grant. May sell Shout Outs for \$5 to include in the program. February fundraiser is selling chocolate, cheese, sausage, and candles through Mr. Allen.

Mrs. Foster hoped that communication between Maestros and PTSA can be improved. Maybe the school can join the Main St Business Assoc. Nichole Williams is president of PTSA. Dance Dec 8, Music Dec 11. Raise money for Maestros. Art shows start 4-4:30 PM and we need a signup genius to arrange volunteers to speak at those and man a donation table.

West Best Fest same date as last year, Sunday before Derby. Teachers need to make a list of summer opportunities for visual arts, dance and theater. Awards to be chosen by the staff. Brett Owen is considering the purchase of a Kiln and drying rack for the visual arts department.
